

He has worked in the field of health status measurement for over 15 years and developed and validated the St George's Respiratory Questionnaire and AQ20. In addition, he has extensive experience in the design and execution of large trials in asthma and COPD.

He has worked in guideline development in asthma and COPD and established the Cochrane Airways Group. Professor Jones' research into health status assessment continues and he has published widely on health status in peer reviewed papers, review articles and book chapters.
